1. SPECIAL EVENTS

Accomplishments To Date

- Distinct working teams established to tackle host congregation recruiting, transportation, Day Center search and procurement, fund development, and administration
- 14 Host Congregations and 7 Support Congregations committed
- Submitted and approved as a NYS non-profit organization
- Temporary Board of Directors in place, with formal Board search set to begin in April
- 501c3 application submitted and pending approval
- Day Center locations narrowed down to two, with final decision expected by March 30
- In partnership with Habitat for Humanity to help with renovation of selected Day Center space
- · Website and Facebook page launched
- Strategic Work Plan documented
- Holiday appeal in December
- "Bridges Out of Poverty for Churches" workshop held in January with 45+ attendees
- Plan in place for a spring rollout of a youth Rock A Thon (that's chairs, not music) fundraising event
- Grant writing process started
- Ongoing educational meetings with community groups
- Established ability to make online, tax-deductible donations using First Presbyterian Church of Victor as fiscal agent until federal 501c3 status is obtained
- Major summer fundraiser date set for Saturday, July 29 in conjunction with the Canandaigua Lakefront Art Show
